Therefore, in April, Elayne will draw one card, after eliminating 10s through aces, and that card will be the only quad eligible to win the jackpot. For example, if the 7 is drawn, then a player must get quad sevens to win the Super Bonus that month.

4th Saturday of the Month: Elaine is still looking for volunteers to run this tournament in the coming months. If no one steps up to help, the tournament will be cancelled. We will send out an email to the members regarding this issue.

Request for a Wednesday night Tournament:

- a) 1st offense: verbal warning
- b) 2d offense: a 3 hand penalty (the player will be dealt cards for 3 hands but may not look at them and must muck them;
- c) 3rd offense: a full round penalty (the player must leave the table for a full round. He will be dealt cards and they will be mucked.
