Discussion on re-opening the Poker Room:

- Social distancing is not possible for us. Having only 4 players at a table is not feasible.
- It would be difficult for some players to wear face masks for 3 – 4 hours.
- Handling chips and cards with gloves on would be cumbersome.
- Having to take players' temperatures would be confusing since normal temperatures can vary from person to person. Also, coming back to the room after being outside in the hot summer weather would probably increase body temperature levels.
- The Poker Room will be sanitized only after CAM approves our plan for reopening.
- We would expect that players who subject themselves to being in large groupings such as concerts, ball games, casinos, etc. would be asked to isolate themselves for 2 weeks before playing with us. How do we monitor this?
- We would have to purchase disposable table covers since felt covers cannot be sanitized.
- Chips would have to be washed after each use. Who would do this?

LAC Criteria Checklist: CAM has given each club a checklist for re-opening clubs. Using these guidelines, Paul will draw up our club's proposal and submit it to CAM. Ultimately, it will be CAM's decision for reopening our club.

Poker Dues for 2021: Ruth suggested we do not charge dues next year to those players who paid their dues this year.
