Recommendations for \$2 / \$4 Hold-Em:

- a. Have a list of "bankers" who would sell chips, pay off players, be responsible for cabinet keys and protecting money, be responsible for equalizing or consolidating tables, and make sure that table rules are followed.
- b. Each Hold-Em day should have a banker and two assistant alternates. The banker should use a fanny pack in which to store the money during play.

<u>Room Security:</u> The proposal to keep all doors locked while play is in session was not considered to be feasible especially at tournaments when there is constant leaving and entering the room. It would also intrude on chess players who come in at different times on Thursdays. Finally, locked doors could send out a message to outsiders that there are large sums of money in the room. Gene will see that the words "variety of stakes" and "A low stakes table is available" are deleted from the Poker Clubs' announcement in the GRAND TIMES.

<u>Tournament Suggestion Forms:</u> This is the only way the tournament committee will address players' concerns. Forms are posted on the bulletin board and, once filled out, they should be handed to one of the committee members.
