## Board Meeting Wednesday, September 14, 2011

<u>Present:</u> Gene Trinks, Jerry Zickert, Haydee LaBreche, John Pappalardo, Mark Thibaudeau, and Bob Hink

Treasurer's Report: We have \$3975.65 in savings, \$297.02 in checking, and \$337 in cash.

<u>Holiday Party</u>: Wednesday, December 7, 2011. Sharkos will be asked to cater it. There is approximately \$3,000 in club funds for this event.

<u>Old Tournament Chips</u>: The new tournament chips were used for the first time yesterday. We will keep the old chips for a year to see if there is a need for future use. After that we will find a way to dispose of them.

<u>Free Roll Tournament:</u> Date: Friday, September 23. Gene will make sure the room has been reserved. We estimate that there will be about 80 players between the two sessions.

## **Tournament Committee Report:**

- Newsletter: The committee has expressed an interest in establishing a newsletter to be e-mailed to players every two months or so. There would be different topics covered each issue. The Board requested a fully detailed proposal of the specifics and Jerry was asked to bring a sample to the Board for final approval.
- Thursday entry fee: The survey to raise the fee to \$15 was not conclusive enough to warrant the change from the present \$10. This proposal will go back to committee for further study.
- There are no plans to have training sessions for new players this fall.
- <u>Distribution of Promotional Funds:</u> There were 8010 players in all sessions so far this year. We distributed \$1835 during the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter which ended in September. Dealer's Choice and limit Hold-Em players who account for 44% of all members received 42% of the funds while tournament players who account for 56% of members received 58% of the funds.
- <u>Charities:</u> There is an interest in participating in some type of charity as a club. One of the ideas expressed was to choose one week in early November and ask members to donate either a can of food or give a monetary donation earmarked for the Food Bank. This proposal was generally well received; however, the discussion centered around giving an extra 500 chips to tournament players as an incentive for their donation. There are no incentives for the Dealer's Choice and limit Hold-Em players because of the nature of their games. This proposal will go back to committee for further discussion.

<u>Membership Fees:</u> New members joining the club from November 1<sup>st</sup> to the end of the year will be charged a reduced fee of \$5 and will not be eligible to receive a free ticket to the Holiday Party.

November Elections: Bill Cleland will be asked to have a slate of candidates by October 15 so we can publish it by October 28 for voting one month later.
