Ronnie and Angelo will get helpers to set up and clean up on Monday, Oct. 7; and Haydee and Bob will do the same on Wednesday, Oct. 30.

Each twosome is also responsible for calling in the order to Craig at Florencia's Pizzeria (584-5858) at least 2 days before the pick-up date and for making a follow-up call the morning prior to the meal.

<u>Holiday Party:</u> Haydee will get in touch with Gerard at Sharko's Caterers and request two serving stations using four lines regardless of the number of guests in attendance.

SCG Poker Club Guest Policy: The policy has been revised and finalized as of 9/2013 as follows:

- 1. A SCG poker club member in good standing may bring a guest (resident or non-resident) to any poker session. The club member does not need to remain and participate in that poker session.
- 2. A non-resident guest may participate in any SCG poker session 3 times per calendar year sponsored by a poker club member.
- 3. A SCG resident may be a guest for one poker session and, on their second time playing, this guest will be required to join the SCG Poker Club. The exception is for residents who are non-members who participate in the "poker lessons" which they have signed up to take.
- 4. Any guest who participates in a non-catered SCG Poker Club event (e.g. the Spring Picnic) must pay the guest event fee of \$1 which is included in the cost of the event.
- 5. Effective September 8, 2013, a \$3 guest fee will be applied for any non-member who participates in our "pizza nights". This will make them a SCG Poker Club member for that day. An additional \$1 table fee will be paid if the non-member guest participates in the poker session that day.

"Have you always wanted to learn how to play Omaha Hi-Low or Texas Hold-em? You can at the SCG Poker Club.
