The Board approved the following:

- Wednesday's Omaha Tournament will now start at 10:00 a.m.
- The 1st & 3rd Saturday Hold'em Tournament will now start at 9:00 a.m.

Board Members responsibilities:

- John will work on reviewing the payout schedule for tournaments and work with Adam Bona to refresh the TDA rules and club rules to be put into a handbook for the club.
- John and Bruce will set up a TD training session and will schedule TDs to run tournaments.
- In the Fall, Betty will make a presentation to the Board with suggestions on how to improve the Annual Meeting and the Holiday Party.

A Member's Request to have a table count of all the chips in play at the end of a tournament was voted down by all.

<u>Marge Cross Memorial Tournament</u>: Marge's family has asked permission to have a Hold'em Tournament in her honor Sunday, June 5th and provide a meal (pizza?). The tournament would be open to Marge's family and friends as well as club members. The Board approved the request. There is still a question as to what the entry fee will be but the Board agreed that Marge's family could play for free. Kurt Lauffer will run the game. More details to follow.

Steve Weinstein made the following presentation:

- After taking a survey of those who played the All Club Tournament, 29 of the 33 replies said they would play again and the majority said they would play quarterly rather than once a month. The Board approved holding this tournament four times a year.
- The blind structure will be changed.
- Pizza might be in the offering.

Steve suggested we introduce new games to attract more players, such as:

- 5-card draw with jacks or better to enter;
- survivor hold'em tournament for \$30 \$40;
- an additional day for cash games (presently only on Mondays at 5:00 p.m.)
- an additional 7-card stud game some afternoon (presently only on Tuesdays at 9:00 a.m.)
